

Bicycle, Walk and Skateboard Policy

Students are expected to follow all local laws when traveling to and from school. All bicycle, scooter and skateboard riders are encouraged to wear a helmet and REQUIRED to walk their bike, scooter or skateboard on the sidewalks surrounding the school upon arrival to and dismissal from campus as well as through all crosswalks. When in the cueing lane students must walk their bikes, scooters or skateboards. It is recommended that students walk their bikes, scooters or skateboards on all sidewalks when there is traffic.

All bicycles must be parked in the bike racks. All bicycles must be locked by 7:55 promptly when school starts so please be on time. Although Arizona Charter Academy has designated an area for students to park bicycles, Arizona Charter Academy is not responsible and assumes no liability for theft, damage, or loss of use to any bicycle or equipment. All such risk is assumed by the student. Students must secure their bicycles in an appropriate manner by using a quality lock and chain.

Skateboards are allowed on campus and need to be checked in with the front office prior to the student's 1st period class. This means by 7:55. At no time are skateboards allowed to be stored in classrooms or carried throughout the day. Please make sure your child arrives on time to check in their skateboard.

Students who are eligible to ride bikes, walk, or skateboards to school must follow these rules:

- Walk bicycle from edge of school property and across crosswalks; bicycles and scooters must be walked in crosswalks and once on the school grounds. Skateboards, rollerblades, etc. must be similarly carried.
- One rider per bike
- Park bike in racks provided
- Store skateboard with front office
- Lock the bike
- Use the crosswalk when crossing the street
- Walk on the sidewalk

Crosswalk and Crossing Guards:

To ensure safety, ACA strongly encourages, and we expect families to use the designated crosswalks when crossing either Dysart or Market Street. There is a designated crosswalk on Dysart and Grand Ave, Dysart and Greenway and Dysart and Market Street. ACA does not have any certified crossing guards at any of these locations.
